Street Sweeping

Public Works has completed street sweeping but will be touching up areas as needed throughout the season.

Safe Step will be coming to the Northome section of town within the next two weeks to assess sidewalk panels that may need to be shaved due to tree roots or ground movement.

They would then begin the trip hazard mitigation (shaving panels down) in the following 30 to 45 days.

Tree trimming by Uppercut Tree Services in the Northeast Quadrant was delayed.
